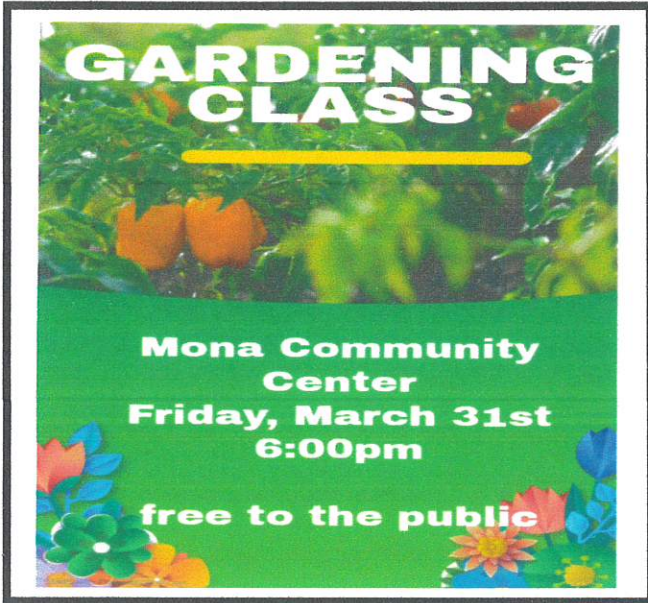

Jumper is a little colt's inspiring journey after being separated from his birth mother who becomes addicted to a toxic plant. From fear and loss to healing and hope, this book tenderly portrays the complexities of addiction, abandonment, trauma and healing.

While invaluable for those involved with foster care or adoption, Jumper is a powerful tool for teaching EMPATHY and a great addition to any family library. JUMPER IS FOR EVERYONE. Thoughtfully written with deep sensitivity, Jumper shows an example of unconditional love and it's power to heal, while validating the anger, pain and confusion that can be brought on by trauma.
