

**SECTION 1:            AMENDMENT “8-5-2 IRRIGATION WATER”** of the Mona City Code is hereby *amended* as follows:

AMENDMENT

8-5-2 IRRIGATION WATER

- A. Irrigation water must be delivered to the lot in a system from a reputable and functioning irrigation company, with a governing board, that can confirm ownership and delivery of the water. It must also be approved by the City and Mona Irrigation Company.
- B. Irrigation water to be used for building must be dedicated to Mona City and be deliverable to the lot for 7 out of 7 days. Fulfillment of this obligation must continue through the irrigation season.
- C. The delivering system must have a minimum pressure of 40 psi, without a booster pump, at the connection. A 3/4 inch pipe is required for a 1/2 acre lot. A larger pipe may be required for a larger lot, but must be approved by the City and the Mona Irrigation Company.
- D. A minimum of 1 acre foot, or 1/4 share if using Mona Irrigation town water, is required per half acre. for each building permit. If a lot size exceeds .7 acres, more water may be required.
- E. There shall be no wells drilled within Mona City limits, including for the use of irrigation water, with the exception of wells owned and operated by Mona City or Mona Irrigation Company.
- F. Outside of Mona City limits cannot be used for water inside Mona City limits, with the exception of wells owned and operated by Mona City or Mona Irrigation Company.
