#### 2019 FIREWORKS SALES AND DISCHARGE DATES

**Sales**

Class "C" fireworks can be sold the following dates:

- June 24 – July 25
- December 29 – December 31st
- 2 days before and on Chinese New Year's Eve

**Discharge**

Between the hours of 11am and 11pm except as noted:

- July 2 – July 5  
(July 4 hours extended to midnight)
- July 22 – 25  
(July 24 hours extended to midnight)
- December 31\*  
(11am – 1am Jan. 1)
- Chinese New Year's Eve  
(11am – 1am the following day)

\*If New Year's eve is on a Sunday and the county, municipality, or metro township determines to celebrate New Year's eve on the prior Saturday (Dec 30), then a person may discharge Class C common state approved explosives on that prior Saturday within the county, municipality, or metro township.
