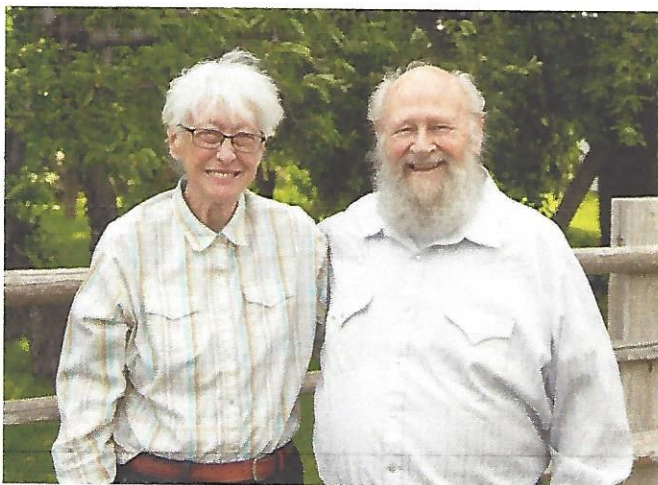
GRAND MARSHALL

AERIAL FIREWORKS PROHIBITED

Due to current and forecasted weather patterns coupled with extremely dry conditions in our county, the Mona City Fire Department has requested the following firework restrictions for residents as a pro-active approach to preventing fires.

- Ground fireworks will be allowed within the city limits with the exception of any area near the foothills or within 200' of any grasslands used for agricultural purposes. Be extra cautious.
- All aerial fireworks are prohibited within the city and surrounding areas.
