Burn permits will be issued March 30th to May 30th. To obtain a permit, Google burn permit Utah and fill out the questions. When submitted it will also be sent to the Fire Chief so he can come and make sure everything is approved to burn. Burn permit will look like the example above.

The city invites you to draw inspiring art and positive messages on the sidewalk. Chalk will be provided.

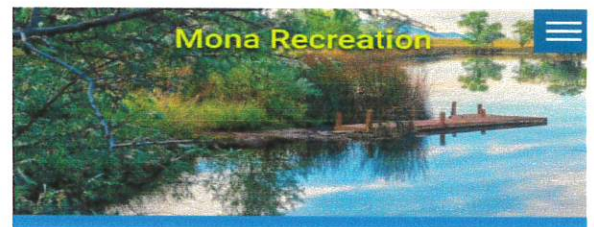
