IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT ATV'S

All off highway vehicles using city streets shall be operated at all times in accordance with all applicable state, county and city laws and regulations, and will not exceed **fifteen (15) miles per hour.**

No person may operate an off-highway vehicle on any land, trail, street or highway designated as open to off highway vehicle use or in the manner unless the person possesses:

- (1) A valid motor vehicle operator's license.
- (2) The appropriate safety certificate.

All operators of off highway vehicles who are eight (8) through thirteen (13) must have an accompanying adult.

No person under eight (8) years of age may operate and no owner may give another person who is under eight (8) years of age permission to operate an off-highway vehicle on any public land, trail, street or highway of this state.

No person who is eight (8) years of age or older but under sixteen (16) years of age may operate and no owner may give permission to operate an off-highway vehicle unless:

1. He is under the direct supervision of a certified off highway vehicle safety instructor during a scheduled safety training course; or
2. He has in his possession the appropriate safety certificate issued by the division.

It shall be the responsibility of the parent, parents or guardian of all-terrain vehicle riders between the ages of eight (8) to sixteen (16) to educate, inform and make aware the laws and rules of this chapter, and warn them of the penalties or accidents that could harm them or others if not followed.

Unless another penalty is provided for in this chapter, violators shall be guilty of a class C misdemeanor.
