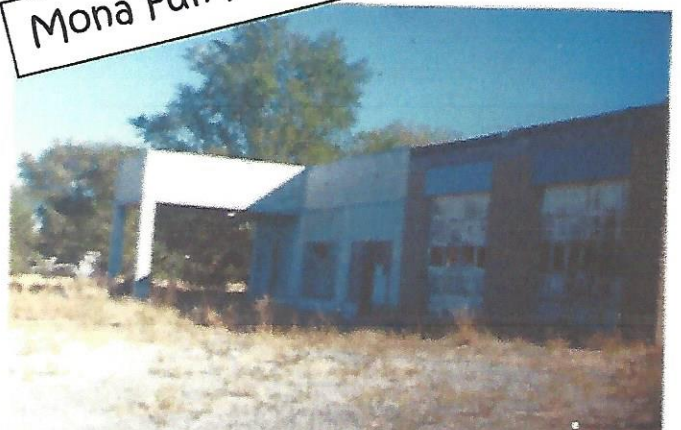
➔ Business Licenses for 2020 are now due.  
Home Businesses are \$18.00 for the year.  
Commercial Businesses are \$36.00 for the year.  
\*New businesses will need to fill out an application that will be approved by the council.  
\*Renewals will need to fill out a form but will not need to go before the council.

Dog tags need to be renewed for 2020.  
Male/female spayed/neutered dogs are \$8.00 for the year.  
Male/female are \$10.00 for the year.  
Kennel Licenses are required for those with three or more dogs.  
Those are \$24.00 per year.

Remember you need a fence permit before installing a fence. There is no charge for this permit.
