In the August 3, 2022 P & Z Work Session, it was proposed that Mona City consider requirements for new subdivisions to install sidewalks. The General Plan states that "while sidewalks, curbs and gutters are prominent features in some cities, respondents to a community survey felt that Mona's rural nature is complemented by a lack of these features." As it has been four years since this survey was completed, the P & Z Commissioners are asking for Mona City residents' input.

We are again showcasing student art from Mona Elementary. Come in and enjoy the beautiful work our young community members are creating!

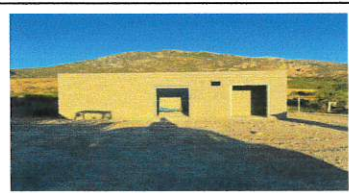
