- ➔ Due to the water rate increase plan that was approved on August 14, 2018, the water rate is now \$31.00 for City Water Customers and \$44.00 for County Water Customers. The allowed usage will remain at 15,000 gallons per month and \$3.00 per thousand overages. Just a reminder that this increase is a five-year plan for the Master Plan Capital Improvements Project. We are now in the fourth year.

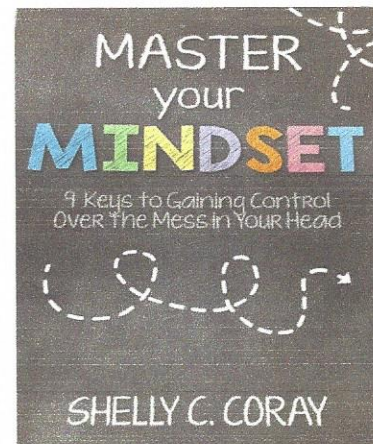
