WATER RATE INCREASE

Due to the water rate increase plan that was approved on August 14, 2018, the water rate is now \$34 for city water customers and \$49 for county water customers. The allowed usage will remain at 15,000 gallons per month and \$3.00 per thousand on overages. Just a reminder that this increase is a five-year plan for the Master Plan Capital Improvements Projects.

OHV Safety Certification Class

This certification class will be taught by a certified instructor and the Juab County sheriff's office. It is available for all youth and adult riders in Juab County.

Effective January 2023 the OHV education course is available online but youth need to complete the online education and the safety comprehensive course on site with an instructor.

Bring your own ATV to class.
Rider must wear a helmet.
A parent or guardian over 18 must accompany youth riders. No cost to attend.
